### **Early Years Free Entitlement (EYFE)**

All children over 3 years old (term after 3) are entitled to 15 hours of free universal early years provision per week. We are offering this entitlement flexibly for 38 weeks of the year. If you take up more than 15 hours the extra time will be charged at £5 per hour.

We can be part of a 30 hour extended offer for eligible parents. See HMRC –Childcare Choices website for further details.

You will be provided with an invoice/contract showing exactly how the provision is offered. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £2 per session. This will be shown on your invoice. This contribution will enable us to keep our staffing ratios and replenish equipment as needed.
